

Dear Marco, I am writing to you as officer of the Drexel University UNA Student Alliance to ask your help in building the American Engagement Caucus in the U.S. House of Representatives.

Some days ago we sent a letter about the Caucus to UNA chapter and division leaders across the country. I am attaching it to this email to give you the background. As you will see, the Caucus provides an unusual opportunity to strengthen support for the United Nations in Congress.

It would be very helpful if the members of your Student Alliance would each communicate with his or her Member of Congress to ask them to join the Caucus. All House Members have received a "Dear Colleague" invitation letter from the Caucus co-chairs, a copy of which is also attached. Additionally, I am attaching some talking points about the Caucus as well as email and phone scripts that you may want to use or adapt.

We know that when constituents make their voices heard Members of Congress are much more likely to respond positively than if they just hear from a Washington Office. Please encourage your members to email or call the office of the Congressional Representative for the district in which they vote and urge his or her participation in the American Engagement Caucus.
